IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

MAP/DIRECTIONS

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.**

When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location and permit number.**

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 12 months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 12 months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

*After 1 (One) year a new permit must be issued for any continued or new work.
